## ORGANIZATIONAL INTRODUCTION

Pak Mission Society (PMS) is a national humanitarian and development organization, licensed under Section 42 (not for profit) of the Companies Act, 2017 with the Securities and Exchange Commission of Pakistan (SECP). Since its inception in 2004, PMS has been dedicated to empowering vulnerable and unreached communities across Pakistan, enabling them to live with dignity, hope, and self-reliance. With footprints in over 47 districts across Pakistan and strong outreach through 10 regional offices, PMS has directly impacted more than one million households and over 6.5 million individuals to date in the fields of Climate & Environmental protection, Food Security & Livelihoods, Water, Sanitation & Hygiene, Disaster Risk Reduction, Leadership & Youth Development, Entrepreneurship Development, Health, and Education.
